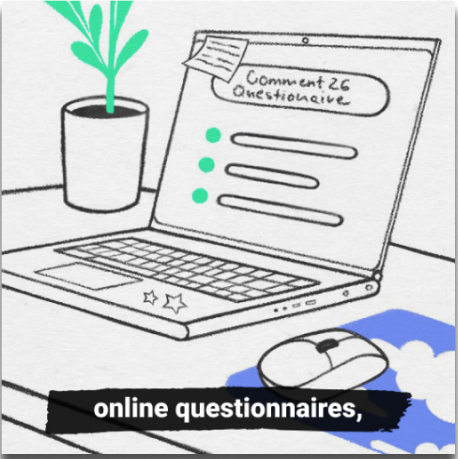
It will hold governments accountable when they violate children's rights and strengthen environmental action.

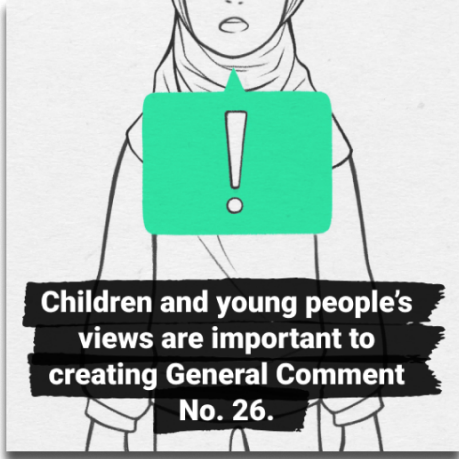

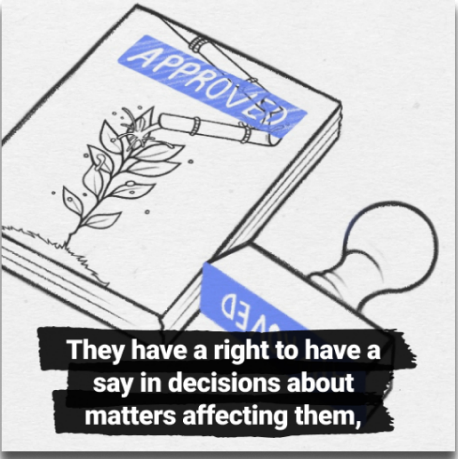

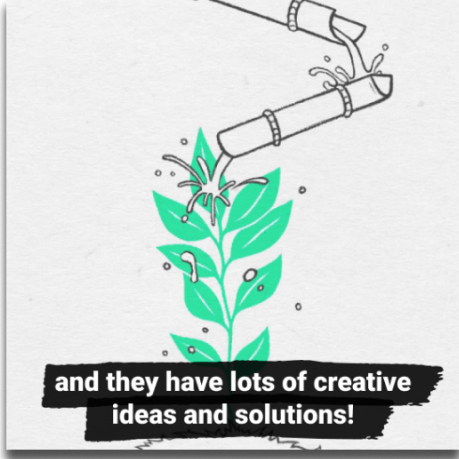
